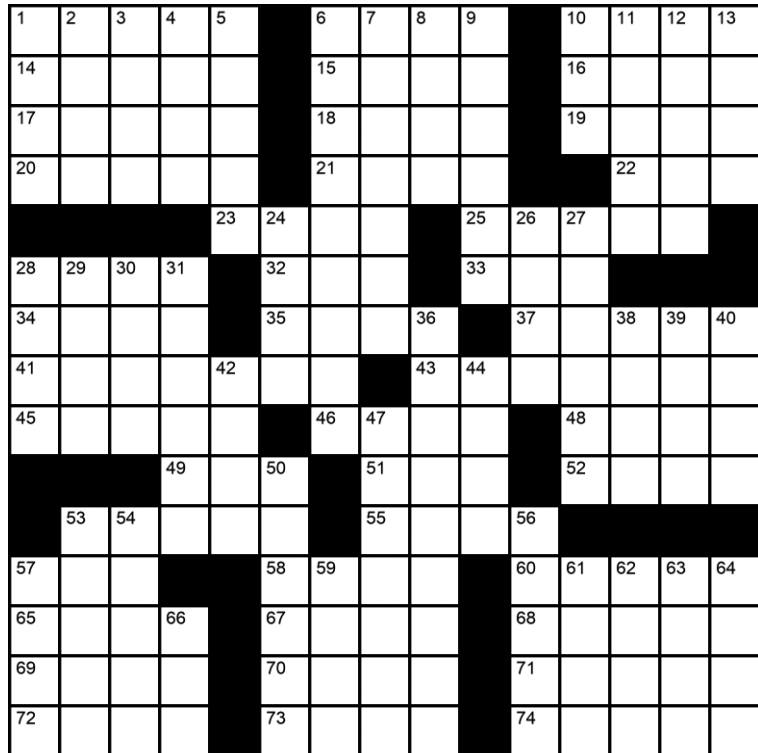

Sudoku is a nine by nine grid. The solution (each puzzle has only one) will have all the numbers from one through nine in every row and every column. In addition, the grid is divided into nine three-by-three sections. Each of these three-by-three sections will also contain all the numbers from one through nine. Each Sudoku puzzle from Pappocom can be solved using logic alone. If you prefer guessing, you can – but there is a logical way to solve every puzzle.

Let's learn another, more complex, way to solve. This complicated, two-step, technique can come in handy. We are putting a 7 in the center section of the easy puzzle that contains 2 and 5. The 7 in the middle section of the top row eliminates the 3 squares on the left edge of the center section. The 7 in the middle section of the top row ALSO eliminates the boxes above the five in the middle section of the bottom row, leaving only the green boxes for a possible 7 there. That eventual 7 in the green boxes will eliminate the center square in the center section marked by red. The 7s in the left and right sections of the middle row eliminate the spaces to the right of the 2 and 5, leaving only the space to the right of the red box for the 7! This is a powerful technique to use if the occasion arises.
