Sudoku is a nine by nine grid. The solution (each puzzle has only one) will have all the numbers from one through nine in every row and every column. In addition, the grid is divided into nine three-by-three sections. Each of these three-by-three sections will also contain all the numbers from one through nine. Each Sudoku puzzle from Pappocom can be solved using logic alone. If you prefer guessing, you can - but there is a logical way to solve every puzzle.
Let's start with the medium puzzle for a new strategy. We will try to put a 7 in the right section of the top row which contains 1-2-4-9. The 7 in the center section eliminates all but the spaces under the 5 and 4 in the center section of the top row. Regardless of which of those spots the 7 will go, it will eliminate the bottom row of the section we are working on. The 7 in the right section of the middle row eliminates the spaces under the 89 , leaving only the space above the for the new 7! You have learned one more technique needed to solve Sudoku puzzles. There are many more.
