Sudoku is a nine by nine grid. The solution (each puzzle has only one) will have all the numbers from one through nine in every row and every column. In addition, the grid is divided into nine three-by-three sections. Each of these three-by-three sections will also contain all the numbers from one through nine. Each Sudoku puzzle from Pappocom can be solved using logic alone. If you prefer guessing, you can - but there is a logical way to solve every puzzle.
Let's start with the easy puzzle. Lets try to put a 5 in the right section of the top row that contains $1,3,9$. The 5 in the right section of the middle row eliminates the spaces above and below the 9 . The 5 in the right section of the bottom row eliminates the spaces below the 1 . The 5 in the middle section of the top row eliminates the spaces to the left of the 9 . The only place left is to the right of the 1 . You have learned a technique needed to solve Sudoku puzzles. There are many more.
