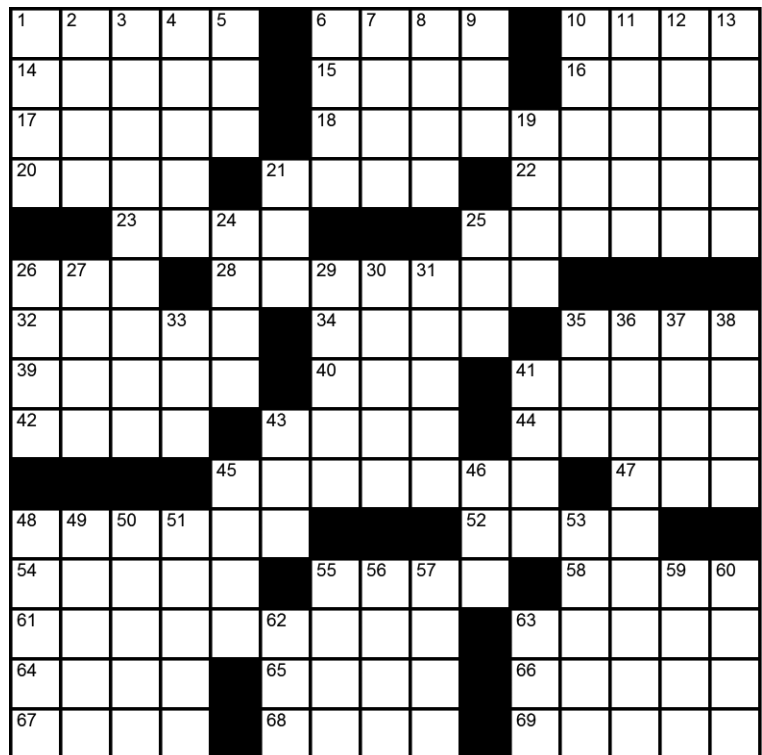

Sudoku is a nine by nine grid. The solution (each puzzle has only one) will have all the numbers from one through nine in every row and every column. In addition, the grid is divided into nine three-by-three sections. Each of these three-by-three sections will also contain all the numbers from one through nine. Each Sudoku puzzle from Pappocom can be solved using logic alone. If you prefer guessing, you can – but there is a logical way to solve every puzzle.

Let's learn another, more complex, way to solve. This complicated, three-step, technique can come in handy. We are putting a 7 in the left section of the top row of the easy puzzle that contains 2,4,6,9. The 3 and 5 in the column below the red box means that 3 nor 5 can be in the three red spaces, leaving only the two green spaces to hold the 3 and the 5. This means 1,7, and 8 must be in the red spaces eventually. Because of the 7s in the sections to the right, the only place for the 7 in the red spaces is in the middle one!

This is a powerful technique to use if the occasion arises.
