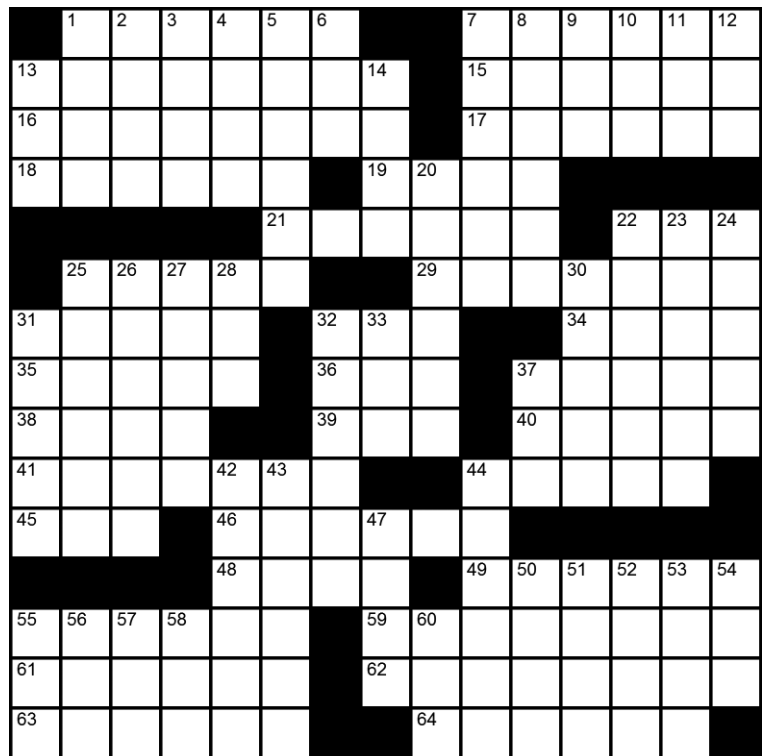

Sudoku is a nine by nine grid. The solution (each puzzle has only one) will have all the numbers from one through nine in every row and every column. In addition, the grid is divided into nine three-by-three sections. Each of these three-by-three sections will also contain all the numbers from one through nine. Each Sudoku puzzle from Pappocom can be solved using logic alone. If you prefer guessing, you can – but there is a logical way to solve every puzzle.

Here is a new, complicated technique that sometimes presents itself. The 5 in the upper right section eliminates the spaces on both sides of the 8 in the middle section of the top row, only leaving the eventual placement of the 5 above or below the 8 (green box). This eventual 5 will eliminate the spaces above and below the 4 in the middle section of the bottom row (blue box). The means the only possible places for a 5 in the middle section of the bottom row are the red squares. Either of those positions will eliminate 5s from the spaces to the left of the 1 in the lower right section. The 5 in the lower left eliminates the spaces on either side of the 3 in the lower right. The 5 in the upper right eliminates the spaces above and below the 1 in the lower right. This only leaves the space to the right of the 6 for a 5 in the lower right!
