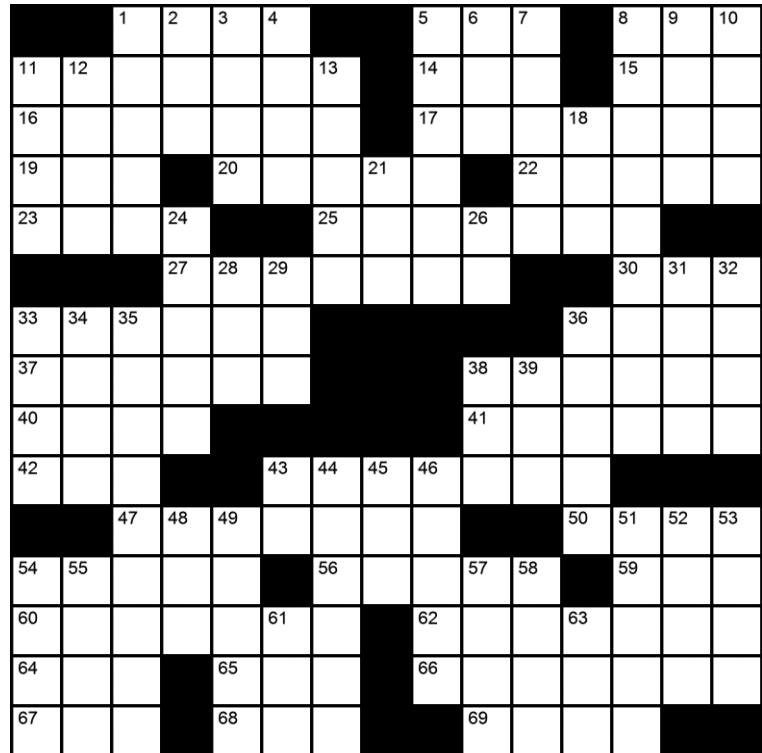

Sudoku is a nine by nine grid. The solution (each puzzle has only one) will have all the numbers from one through nine in every row and every column. In addition, the grid is divided into nine three-by-three sections. Each of these three-by-three sections will also contain all the numbers from one through nine. Each Sudoku puzzle from Pappocom can be solved using logic alone. If you prefer guessing, you can – but there is a logical way to solve every puzzle.

Here is a new, complicated technique that sometimes presents itself. The 8 in the center section of the bottom row eliminates the spaces in the blue box. An eventual 8 will be placed into one of the two red boxes, it won't matter for this move. Either position will eventually eliminate the green box squares to the left. The 8 in the right section of the center row eliminates the space to the left of the 5. The only place left for the 8 in the left section of the middle row is to the left of the 7.
